



MGRR - Invited British Category

Aim:

To include with the MG Racing Register category other British Sports cars to enhance and complement the competition and create greater interest levels for the spectators.

Qualifications:

Submission for inclusion in this category must satisfy the following conditions:-

- Pre-1990 British Sports car-
- A British car manufactured in Britain by a British manufacturer. By necessity the manufacturing company must be of British heritage.
- A Sports Car is a small, usually two seater, two door and designed for spirited performance and nimble handling.
- Engines must be from the same British family ie British Leyland
- Cars of mixed International manufacturers (Ford – Lotus) will not be considered
- Car of mixed British manufactures will be considered (TVR)
- Specifically manufactured or “one off” high-performance race cars that do not fit with the historical image will not be accepted
- Pre 1990 British Sports cars can be enhanced to improve competitiveness in this class. Enhancement can include safety improvements, engine modifications, body improvements and any modifications that were introduced in manufacturer’s competition departments.

Invited British Class 2

All 8 cylinder and 12 cylinder cars with any modifications
